We are pleased to invite you to **II Cracow Conference of Jewish Studies**, organized by Students' Association for Jewish Studies at Jagiellonian University, which will be held at the Jagiellonian University. The Conference is aimed at undergraduate, postgraduate and PhD students undertaking academic issues related to different fields of Jewish Studies. The main goal is to enable them to present their research results. The Conference attempts to provide a platform for the exchange of views, experiences and ideas for young researchers of Jewish Studies. The Conference will deal with issues of Jewish history and culture, as well as topics from other fields relating to Jewish people.

Proposed topics:

- Jewish history and culture from the ancient times until nowadays;
- development and functioning of contemporary Jewish communities in the Diaspora;
- history, politics and society of modern Jewish state;
- the issue of Holocaust;
- the phenomenon of anti-Semitism;
- Jewish thought and religion;
- biblical studies;
- Jewish languages;
- Hebrew, Yiddish, Ladino, Jewish literature;
- Jewish material culture heritage;
- methodology of Jewish Studies;
- Jewish art.

Deadline for proposals: Application form should be sent till the **8th of March 2014** (abstracts should be submitted on the page:

http://smoonote.com/events/79/stages/98/application_form_submissions/new).

The abstract body should have **around 300 - 500 words** and at least 3 entries. Quality of the submitted abstract and the novelty of the topic would be the basis of acceptance. The presentation should last **about 15 - 20 min**. We kindly ask you to present, not to read the paper. It is planned to publish the conference monograph afterwards. We inform you on the abstract evaluation up to **15th of March 2014**.

The conference registration fee is **PLN 30**, which includes food (dinner and snacks) throughout the event. All conference sessions are free and open to the public.
